RESOLUTION 2025-01

At a duly called and conducted meeting of the City of Marion council at 5 o'clock PM on the 17th day of March, 2025, the following resolution was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, by this Order, the duly elected representatives of the city of Marion, hereinafter called Marion, currently owns and maintains the route specifically defined with this resolution and shown on the map attached hereto this Resolution.

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, feels this route logically fits the State Primary Road System, as a bypass for larger vehicle traffic due to the difficulties at the intersection of US 60 and US 641, it is hereby proposed that the Department of Highways agrees to accept ownership and all maintenance responsibilities for the following facilities:

- CS 1095 (Industrial Drive), from the junction of US 641 and extending west to the junction with CS 1117 (Chapel Hill Road), a distance of approximately 0.427 miles. (MP 0.000 to MP 0.427)
- CS 1094 (Country Club Drive), from the junction of US 60 and extending south to the junction with CS 1117 (Chapel Hill Road), a distance of approximately 0.909 miles. (MP 0.000 to MP 0.909)

WHEREAS, upon the acceptance into the State Primary Road System, an Official Order of Transfer will be developed to transfer the ownership and maintenance of the road to the Department of Highways.

NOW THEREFORE, that Marion will execute this Resolution and, thus, hereby agrees to these conditions, and that a signed copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Department.

The foregoing resolution was adopted as above set forth by majority roll call vote of all members of the city council present, a quorum being constituted and said resolution has been duly made a permanent part of the minutes of the city council.
