



## Executive Order 2026-02


### Declaration of a Local State of Emergency


**Whereas**, since January 23, 2026, the City of Marion has been operating under Executive Order 2026-01: and

**Whereas**, significant prolonged freezing conditions are expected to occur throughout the city and county for several more days; and

Now, Therefore, I, D'Anna Browning, Mayor of the City of Marion, by the authority vested in me by KRS39A.100 (2), do hereby declare the additional State of Emergency terms in the City of Marion, Crittenden County which initially began January 23, 2026, for a period determined sufficient for which to allow adequate response to and recovery from this major storm.

1. The January 2026 City Council Meeting is hereby Cancelled. All regular business of the Council for the month of January will be incorporated in the regular meeting of the Council during the February 2026 meeting to allow full public input opportunity.
2. The City of Marion utility bill which includes the period under Executive Order 26-01 will hereby be adjusted to limit the collection of the Environmental Fee to a customer's average fee to recognize the efforts of citizens to proactively prevent water leaks by using dripping methods.
3. Under the State of Emergency, as provided in KRS 39A.100 (2) (d), KRS 38B.070 (6) and 45A.380 (1)(7), The Mayor of Marion and the Judge Executive of Crittenden County can waive procedures and formalities otherwise required by the law pertaining to: a) performance of public work, b) entering into contracts, c) utilization of volunteer workers, d) employment, g) appropriation and expenditures of public funds.
